




Relationship Building: Making decisions together

- Build mutual trust, respect and fairness through team building.
- Acknowledge and list identified strengths and assets.
- Create fair and systems for resource sharing. Facilitate clear and open communication.
- Engage partners and end users in the research plan.





Listening and planning

- Facilitate group discussions that generate a shared mission, values and goals.
- Create a research plan with agreement on measurable outcomes and processes.
- Plan a process for closure with sustainability.





Community Impact

- Short term- Partnership agreement on measures of progress.
- Medium term- Partnership plans sustainability and focus on community health.
- Long-term: Partnership improves the health and lives of the community.

Partnership mentors new members and builds systems of health





Partnership Agreements

- Purpose, goals, objectives
- Expectations, outcomes, anticipated benefits
- Roles, responsibilities, organizational chart
- Sharing of resources and community payment
- Copyright and ownership issues
- Evaluation process
- Dissemination plan



Fiscal Equity

Barriers

- Communication gaps
- Limited support to community partners' fiscal capacity
- Lack of awareness of each partner's processes, procedures, and needs
- Complex administrative processes

Facilitators

- Fair contracts and payments to community partners
- Early and timely communication among all partners
- Engagement throughout preand post-award processes



Action Steps



Include community partners in pre- and post-award administrative processes



Be transparent with partners about approval processes and payment timelines




Outline clear procedures for tracking and managing payments



Support partners in building fiscal and administrative knowledge, skills, and infrastructure



Develop flexible infrastructure to deliver timely payments to community partners
